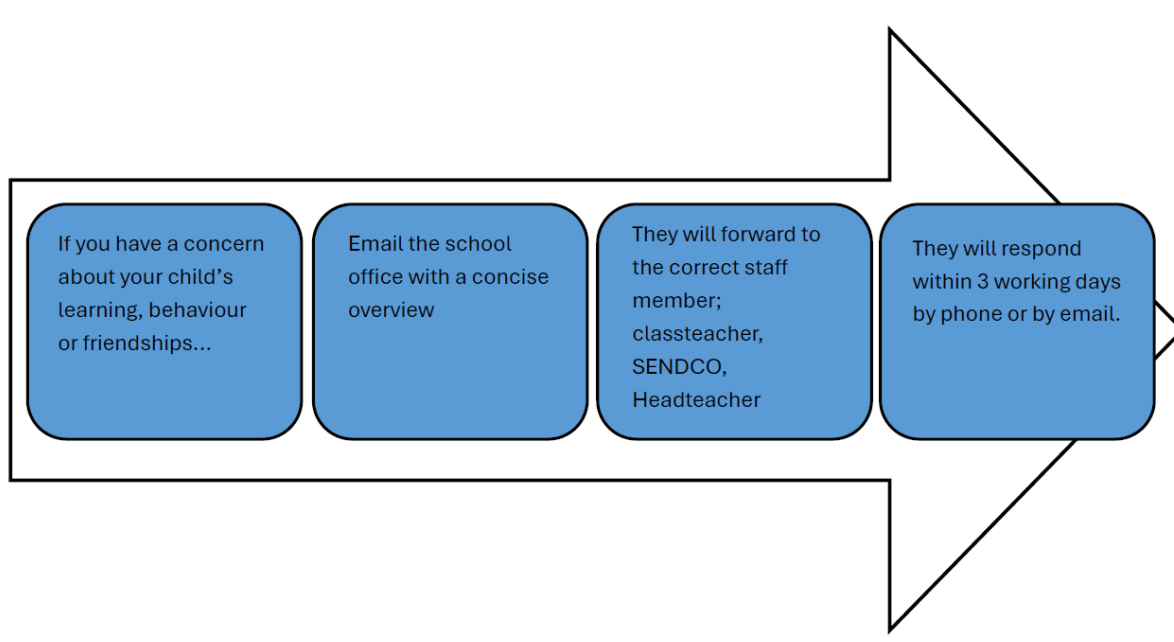
## Headteacher/SENDCO days of the week and email communication:
